

Program Safety Sheet



PROGRAM NAME: **Roseville Fall Skate School- Daytime**

The following safety sheet has been created to share important information to keep participants and instructors safe. If you have any additional questions, please contact the Program Supervisor:

Program has been modified:

- *Class sizes have been modified to a maximum of 30 participants per session to follow current guidelines and youth sports restrictions (instructor to student ratio will remain as normal)*
- *Eliminated the use of any commonly touched “training items” during sessions*
- *Instructors have adjusted lesson plans to ensure safe social distancing while out on ice*
- *Staff will be required to wear masks in common areas where social distancing may not be possible- some instructors may choose to also use masks while out on the ice.*
- *Skaters encouraged to come prepared and dressed to enter ice upon arrival to facility*
- *Skaters allowed to enter facility only 10 minutes prior to skate time and expected to leave the facility 10 minutes following end of session*
- ***Masks are REQUIRED to enter the facility- patrons 6 years of age and older are REQUIRED to wear a face mask inside the facility per Executive Order 20-81. Skaters are NOT required to wear one while skating on the ice. All parents/guardians are REQUIRED to have a face mask***

Arrival and Departure Information:

- *All skaters to enter facility through the south/main Skating Center entrance doors- skaters will proceed down the stairs/ramp to enter arena through lower level*
- *Each class will be directed to a different lobby area to put skates on/off- following conclusion of the class, visitors to exit facility through a DIFFERENT door than originally entered- Arena side “EXIT” doors or through North facility doors*

Spectator Information:

- *Skaters should be dropped off and picked up. If skaters are younger than 10 years of age, only ONE spectator/chaperone to be present*
- ***Parents/guardians wishing to stay during class, are REQUIRED to keep proper social distancing & are REQUIRED to wear a mask***

Basic Cleaning Information:

- *Skate school staff & arena staff will be disinfecting common touch areas more frequently and after each session- door handles, benches, bathrooms, rental skates, etc.*

Facial Covering Information:

- *All patrons entering the facility ARE REQUIRED to wear a mask*
- *Students can remove masks when ready to enter the ice and are NOT required to wear them while participating in the physical activity of skating*
- *Face coverings can temporarily be removed when eating or drinking, but must be used during all other times.*

It is important to note, that all Roseville Parks and Recreation programs have been planned, developed and conducted following the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and MDH guidelines for Social Distancing in Recreational Programs. Please be aware there is some risk of participating in any activity during the pandemic. Even though we are working to provide as safe as an environment as possible, 100% mitigation cannot be guaranteed for any activity.
